MICROSOFT PUBLISHER

Learn to use the tools and techniques in Microsoft Publisher to produce posters, newsletters and other school publications.

iPODS & iPADS

Discover how iPods & iPads can enhance your teaching and use different 'Apps' to help students learn in creative new ways.

SCRATCH

Learn how to use Scratch to teach sequencing and control. Covers sprite creation, commands, loops and procedures.

INTRODUCTION TO iLIFE

During the session, you will be introduced to the iLife suite using iWeb, iPhoto, Garageband and iMovie. We will be creating short pieces of work for each element of iLife.

CREATING PRESENTATIONS WITH KEYNOTE

You will learn how to develop interactive lesson resources, add film and music to your slides, create your own themes and add animations.

CREATING INTERACTIVE IMAGES WITH FIREWORKS

The main aim of this session is to learn the tools available in Fireworks, create interesting graphics and interactive menus. You will also learn how to work with images to make them interactive, an ideal learning resources you can implement in the classroom.

MICROSOFT ACCESS

This session is around using the tools in Microsoft Access to learn the key concepts around building databases and how to generate reports from the data.

INTRODUCTION TO AUDACITY AND GARAGE BAND

You will learn how to make your own music tracks from pre-set instruments and samples from a variety of genres as well as recording music that you create yourself. You will learn how to create a podcast and import still images and video in order to create an enhanced podcast or vidcast.

CREATING GAMES WITH MICROSOFT POWERPOINT

Using Powerpoint to create interactive lesson resources and presentations by adding film, music and animations.

DIGITAL BLUE ANIMATION

Learn how to create exciting stop frame animations using special effects and sound effects to add that finishing touch. Digital Blue cameras are available for loan as part of your media box, subject to availability.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY & PHOTOSHOP

Learn how to edit and enhance your digital photographs by using the tools and techniques available in the industry standard application Photoshop. You will learn how to add effects and apply the many different professional techniques to produce artistic results and how to pass those skills on to your learners.

CREATIVE STORY TELLING WITH AUDIOBOOKS

In this session you will learn how to digitally record sound, add effects and chapters to create your own audio book that will bring your storytelling to life. You can then use your new audio skills in the classroom and your students can share their books with each other.

SLA Credit Allocations
